Don,

My answers are in blue and follow your questions.

Since you won't discuss matters on the phone, and request that I email questions, here are some questions:

1. **Did you make the decision to not talk with me on the phone?** Yes. If not you, who so directed/instructed you?
2. **The HWB website identifies Coleman Smith as a new staffer. What is his background?** Previous to working here, Coleman Smith worked as a permit writer at NMED's AQB. He has a PhD in physical chemistry. **What is his role with the WIPP team?** He is working on everything.
3. **Has NMED extended its timeframe to issue a decision on the pending class 2 modification submitted in April 2013 or is it planning to make the decision within the 90-day timeframe?** NMED is planning on deciding by the 8<sup>th</sup>.
4. **When will NMED make any announcements about the status/schedule for the class 3 permit modifications submitted in March 2013?** NMED does not have a planned date for an announcement about the status/schedule.
5. **Did NMED make a presentation at the most recent WIPP Quarterly meeting?** Yes. If so, why is it not posted on the HWB website? We decided not to post it in part because it was very large (i.e it has a video embedded in it).
6. **Who is hosting the next WIPP quarterly meeting?** EMNRD is hosting. **What is the date and location of the meeting?** July 24 at EMNRD. I would verify this with EMNRD as I have not received any confirmation.
7. **In the past, when I requested Waste Stream Profile Forms (WSPF), I would receive them within a day or two. Why have the WSPFs in the IPRA request of June 20 not been provided?** The documents have been ready since Friday. I have been waiting for our IT folks to load the files to the FTP site. Once that is complete, we will email you. We had to find and scan several files from the record.
