Summary of today's 1:00 PM phone call:

Results obtained from air samples collected on Feb 18th from the Mills Ranch (2.7 DPM), Smith Ranch (4.2 DPM), and Carlsbad (1.3 DPM) sampling locations were discussed. Each value represents samples taken from February 11th through February 18th. New filters were installed on the 18th and will be pulled on the 25th (1 week). According to Rob Hayes at the site, these values are "If you convert to concentration values, they are between 10 and 100 times larger than ubiquitous background for Americium in the area - for that day. A typical filter sample would be an order of magnitude lower." When converting to risk, it is still low but there was definitely a release. When they present the data tomorrow in a table, they will convert it into a more understandable format that uses a baseline assessment. I am sure Susan and Tom can shed some light on this too.

They want to get this data to the public ASAP but not today – probably tomorrow.

They are also taking soil and water samples but these typically take 3 weeks for results.

They are monitoring the HEPA filters in the exhaust filter building. They measure the differential pressure across the filters and the values are remaining low and continuing to perform as expected. Plans are in place for changing the "roughing filter" (aka pre-filter).
