The purpose of this letter is to notify the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) that the Permittees intend to begin use of the authorized Surge Storage Area in the contact-handled (CH) portion of the Waste Handling Building (WHB) at the Waste Isolation Pilot Plant (WIPP) facility. This notification fulfills the requirements of the WIPP Hazardous Waste Facility Permit (Permit), (NM4890139088-TSDF), Permit Part 3, Section 3.1.1.4. Surge Storage will be used in accordance with items 12(d) and 12(g) of the NMED February 27, 2014, Administrative Order.


The Permittees require use of the Surge Storage Area in the CH portion of the WHB as detailed in our referenced letter of February 26, 2014. The Permittees anticipate using the CH Bay Surge Storage Area beginning in March.
