The map of the DOE OB monitoring sites requires 2 maps due to local versus regional scales. Map 1 (draft attached) is a close-up of WIPP facility with the air (exhaust & ambient), soil, vegetation and gamma radiation monitoring locations. Map 2 will be a regional map since it has to show Carlsbad to Malaga to Southeast Control. We are still working on the second map.

We plan on having a multipage pdf for placement on the webpage. The first few pages would be a draft narrative that lists the locations and media and narrates our sampling programs (what sampling frequency means, what analysis we perform). The last 2 pages would be the regional and the close-up maps.
