- Status – Everything is operating as before – still have decision to put HEPA filter at window – working on work plan - putting in parts and over the weekend.
- Sample Analysis – Air Charts first tab, all the radiochemistry results from 26 and collected on third of March, most is below lab background – elevated al[has are artifact of shortened decay time, draft of background for Am241 and Pu239 based on last three ACER's max and med listed there, env air filter status chart – look at units - you can adjust units to compare by multiply by 10^6 . Hoping to get in format for web today, no plan for press release for this data.
- Soil samples results will be in tomorrow and will share
- Recovery Actions – salt shaft and air intake shaft inspections on Friday, couple mine hoist inspectors are in and inspecting, manned reentry early next week.
- Site Status – workers to site – phase approach – CAM installed at Station B – real time alert. Installation in next 10 days and then steady relocation
- Doing Operational Drills – response actions in case of loss of power
- Statement on web about damper 0.4% inefficiency – they had estimated 250 cfm with 60,000 exhausted...not comfortable with that and removed it.
- Accident Board Investigation Report comes out tomorrow – won't be "pretty". May not be able to send people UG until issues in report is addressed
- Plan is to webcast the meeting tomorrow night – City Council will facilitate and will webcast 5:30 PM - will send details when they get them.
- Please take look at sample results and background paper – they want feedback on this.
