

### **LANL shipments continue to Waste Control Specialists**

To date, the Waste Control Specialists (WCS) facility in Andrews, Texas, has received and processed 22 shipments of defense-generated transuranic waste from Los Alamos National Laboratory. The WIPP Central Characterization Project mobile loading unit and crew went to WCS to safely unload the disposal containers.

Plans include completing up to 10 shipments per week to WCS. All shipments are using WIPP's transportation protocols and procedures, and all waste meets WCS permit requirements and WIPP waste acceptance criteria. This transuranic waste will be shipped to WIPP for final disposal after the site reopens.
