Attached is the list of action items, filter performance data, and station A/B data.

Below is a summary of activities: (Please note, activities and dates are subject to change. Please verify the most current dates of any information provided).

- Underground remains in Filtration Mode utilizing Fan 860B. (Switched from 860A on 4/18)
- The CAM at Station B is functioning. The latest reading was reported at 0.1 DAC-hrs. The alarm will be set at 40 DAC-hrs. NWP plans to return approximately 90 additional workers to the site on 4/23. They have four new friskers on site.
- SS and AIS Shaft/Rope Inspections Due: The weekly MSHA inspection of the AIS and SS will be performed today. Completed already.
- Contamination survey to the waste face (Phase 3):
 - Activity 2, 3 & 4: Procedures and safety documentation are being updated for the next entry. The entry is scheduled for Wednesday, 4/23. Entry will be conducted in Level B PPE for approach to the waste face. Electric golf carts will be used for folks in Type B suits up to 2520. Cart speed will be limited to walking speed.



- NWP has determined that they can be task ready to replace ventilation filters on 5/12.
- The current Mod filter DPs are: 856 HEPA Bank – 1.81; 857 HEPA Bank – 1.40. The alarm set point is 3.0.
- Shipments of TRU waste from LANL to WCS continue. Ten shipments are scheduled this week (32 Total).
- Four TRUPACT-II's scheduled for routine off-site maintenance will be surveyed this afternoon. To survey in WHB.
- The AIB report on the radiological release is anticipated to be released later this week.
- The next Town Hall meeting is scheduled for Wednesday 4/23.
- Kathy Economy – hasn't heard status/needs current survey – Scott Kennedy gave her a summary.
- Kathy Economy – Is it common to have radon reading similar to 4/18 (0.1 DAC hours) at Salt Shaft? Scott: Yes, especially when overcast with high humidity.
- Nick Stone – Was CAM set at 8 DAC hr? Scott: 8 DAC hr. Nick: Why some at 40 and others at 8? Scott: Will get rad con person to discuss
- Action Items: Item 15 will be closed. Item 20 – NMED is still reviewing. Item 35 – Will be posted on ICLN soon.
