Attached is the list of action items, filter performance data, station A/B data and depiction of the surface exhaust configuration.

Below is a summary of activities: (Please note, activities and dates are subject to change. Please verify the most current dates of any information provided).

- Underground remains in Filtration Mode utilizing Fan 860B. (Switched from 860A on 4/18)
- The CAM at Station B is functioning. The CAM continues to report 0.1 DAC-hrs. The alarm is set at 40 DAC-hrs. NWP plans to return approximately 90 additional workers to the site on 4/23.
- SS and AIS Shaft/Rope Inspections: The weekly MSHA inspection of the AIS and SS was successfully performed yesterday with no issues.
- Contamination survey to the waste face (Phase 3):
 - Activity 2, 3 & 4: Pre-job meeting is being performed this afternoon and entry is expected early tomorrow morning. Will send call in number shortly.
- The remaining HEPA filters were received yesterday and NWP is on schedule for complete replacement of filters on 5/12.



- The current Mod filter DPs are: 856 HEPA Bank – 1.75; 857 HEPA Bank – 1.36. The alarm set point is 3.0.
- Shipments of TRU waste from LANL to WCS continue. Ten shipments are scheduled this week (32 Total).
- Two TRUPACT-IIs were surveyed during the night-shift last night. Two more will be surveyed during the night-shift tonight. 3 Units are scheduled to be shipped to the maintenance facility tomorrow.
- Nick Stone: Where is waste in TRUPAKs going? No waste in these – they are empty.
- Nick Stone: What about waste that is there? What is plan for that now? DOE: We are not sure. Will try to get answer from tomorrow morning M&O meeting.
- EPA: Pulling second week of filters today. Will do one more week period. Preliminary results will be available in 10 days with final results a couple weeks beyond that.
- Total of 22 shipments to WCS as of today.
