What is your proposed filter sampling/swap out schedule? And how are your systems set up? These 2 items would be the deciding factors in how much assistance we could offer. We can also offer space for filter prep, filter storage in a locked sample cabinet, and equipment/tool storage at our Carlsbad office.

Catrina Johnson and I will be in Carlsbad next week for our ambient air filter swap out. Our filter swaps are every other Tuesday and we have Oversight Bureau staff scheduled for all the foreseeable filter swaps.

Since we will be at the site next week, I propose Catrina and I meet up with your staff and be trained on your systems. That would also allow us to discuss equipment maintenance, chain of custody, sample control, sample storage, etc.

If you have any procedures (sampling, maintenance, O&M, etc.) or schematics it would be help if you could forward them to us.

Hello,
As you know, EPA plans to do an inspection and air sampling next week at the WIPP site. Beginning on Monday, we plan to set up air samplers at three sites (WIPP Far Field, East and South) co-located with DOE samplers. We would like to let them run for 2 to 3 weeks, but we would also like to let our people return home before the end of the sampling. However, we would need to switch out the filters a couple of times. We are looking at different options for the filter changes, and we would like to talk to you about whether NMED could help us.
