I'm following up on our phone call earlier this morning. Skibitski needed me to stay in Albuquerque this week, so I won't be joining you in Carlsbad for the EPA ambient air monitoring training. The EPA staff who will be training you in how to pull the filters are:

Christopher and Sam (EPA lab in Montgomery, AL)

Scott (EPA lab in Las Vegas, NV)

They plan to meet you in the WIPP parking lot at 8am on Tuesday morning.

Your contact is Christopher. His cell phone is 334-425-5914.

EPA loaned us unit so we could "play" with it last week. It is sitting on the lab bench in the OB Carlsbad office. Feel free to investigate the unit when you get to Carlsbad today. You will need to the unit and box to EPA it Tuesday morning. The sample bags, extra filters, forceps, chain of custody and filter housing should be left with the OB since we will need them for filter change out.

You will need gloves. Our current inventory is in the cabinet above the lab sink.

Since you are working on behalf of the Oversight Bureau this week, feel free to use the Bureau Ford Expedition (parked at the DOE OB office in Carlsbad). Krissie can show you where the sigh-out, gas card and keys are. The three EPA locations (Far Field, WIPP East, WIPP South) are all within the exclusive use area or just across the street. WIPP East and South require driving on sandy unimproved roads, so I would take the Expedition just to be able to power through the sand.

If you have any questions, give me a call. I will forward your cell # to Christopher.

Krissie is expecting you later today. She can provide you with any assistance you need while in staying in our office.
