

WF14-117 Root Cause Hold



The root cause investigation for WF14-117 was completed by NWP and a draft Root Cause report was reviewed. During this review there was a question regarding the identified root cause. As the root cause included elements outside the CCP certified program involving the generator site responsibilities, it was decided that the CCP Root Cause was premature and would be placed on hold until the generator site and the Accident Investigation Board had completed their investigation regarding events leading up to the WIPP Form.
