The meeting lasted about an hour and was attended by more than 100 people, by my estimation. It was conducted by Ms. Tammy Reynolds, Central Characterization Program Manager, for Nuclear Waste Partnership. The topic was basically a fairly detailed overview about where they are (approaching the end of Phase I: Mitigation) and where they are going (Phase II: Recovery and Resumption, with a goal of 2018 to be fully functional). The various elements of Phase II were described. Special emphasis was placed on a need to construct a new ventilation system to increase the output from the current 60,000 CFM to around 400,000 CFM. At the end I asked a question so as to establish the presence of NMED at the meeting. There is another meeting at 2:00 today I am attending which I suspect may contain similar content.

Tammy will also be attending tonight's town hall meeting in Carlsbad, part of which will probably be a summary of her earlier presentation. I will ask her at that time if NMED can get a copy or at least a print out of her presentation.
