Today at the 10:00 AM call, NMED was told that they would not share this presentation. They did offer to come give the presentation again. NMED also asked for the literature analysis of catalytic nitration that they mentioned in the presentation. They indicated they would share this as well but now, will not.

Below is a summary of activities for today's call. (Please note that activities and dates are subject to change. Please verify the most current dates of any information provided.)

- No entry today.
- An entry was made yesterday to continue radiological rollback efforts in the U/G. The area around the waste hoist has been rolled back to a RBA to be able to operate the waste hoist. Additional rollback entries are planned throughout this week.
- The Salt Shaft and Air Intake Shaft rope inspections are to take place next Monday and Tuesday.
- The samples from Panel 7 Room 7 well be shipped to SRNL today for analysis.
- The video imaging boom fabrication, testing, and implementation is on schedule. The week of 9/15 has been targeted for the equipment to be ready for assembly in the U/G. Mapping of Room 7 is expected to take two weeks following assembly.
- Bolting operations in the U/G is anticipated to start in mid-September. Trais heard at the town hall that they considering ordering an electric/diesel hybrid bolter. They developing specification for the
- The two HEPA skid mounted ventilation units are proceeding on schedule.
- The Next Town Hall Meeting is scheduled on 9/4/14.



- DOE is currently reviewing Rev. 2 of the Recovery Plan – DOE comments due end of this week, turn around will be provided to DOE by Sept 8th, Anticipate it will be issued as final by end of October.
- NMED asked about status of waste hoist. Working aggressively to get on line... don't have a date.
- NMED asked about status of getting an AIB member for the calls. Russ "booted up the chain" but has not heard.
- NMED asked about % completeness of habitability of UG. Until waste hoist is available it is hard to say ... percentage would be low... First or second entry did approx. 150 sq ft. Will try to give us a map a week. (Surveyed 1 mile of total 12 miles).
