WIPP UPDATE: June 11, 2015

Senior DOE Officials Return to WIPP

Two senior Department of Energy officials – David Klaus, Deputy Under Secretary for Management and Performance, and Dr. Monica Regalbuto, Associate Principal Deputy Assistant Secretary for Environmental Management – visited the Waste Isolation Pilot Plant (WIPP) the week to meet with management, employees and the community and assess WIPP recovery progress. They also toured the WIPP underground to see firsthand the significant recovery progress that has been made.

The most recent milestones include the isolation of the nitrate salt bearing waste containers associated with the breached drum through closure of Panel 6 and Panel 7, Room 7. There has also been progress on the interim ventilation system, which will increase the overall amount of airflow in the underground facility from the 60,000 cubic feet per minute (CFM) available under the current configuration to 114,000 CFM.
