They wanted to make us aware that there was an orderly, non-emergency evacuation of the underground today.

Apparently, there was an issue with the MSHA monitors. The monitors are used for measuring things like methane and oxygen for worker-safety purposes. In an abundance of caution, they evacuated the underground so they could get the issue sorted out.
