NMED has reviewed the 2016 WIPP Biennial Environmental Compliance Report (BECR).

The 2016 BECR appropriately captures the three Administrative Orders that NMED issued to the WIPP Permittees in 2014 to address specific Permit noncompliance's as a result of the February 2014 fire and radiologic release events. The 2016 BECR also appropriately captures the January 22, 2016 Settlement Agreement and Stipulated Final Order that resolved the December 6, 2014 Administrative Compliance Order that was issued to the WIPP Permittees for violations of the Hazardous Waste Act, Hazardous Waste Management Regulations and the Facility RCRA Permit.

As a result of the 2014 Administrative Orders and the 2016 Settlement Agreement, the WIPP Permittees are in compliance with the Facility RCRA Permit for the reporting period of the 2016 BECR- April 1, 2014 through March 31, 2016.
