RE: Notice to Generator/Storage Site Waste Control Specialists LLC

Dear Mr. Williams and Ms. Sanchez:

The purpose of this letter is to inform you that the Waste Isolation Pilot Plant (WIPP) facility has the appropriate Permit issued under the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Act and the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act and will accept the transuranic (TRU) mixed waste that will be shipped from Waste Control Specialists LLC, as long as the TRU mixed waste is in compliance with the applicable provisions of the Permit.

This notice satisfies the WIPP Hazardous Waste Facility Permit condition in Part 2, Section 2.2.2., which states: "Before the Permittees receive TRU mixed waste from an off-site source for the first time, they shall inform the generator/storage site in writing that they have the appropriate Permits for, and will accept, the waste the generator/storage site is shipping. The Permittees shall keep a copy of this written notice as part of the operating record, as required by 20.4.1.500 NMAC (incorporating 40 CFR §264.12(b))."
