PUBLIC SERVICE ANNOUNCEMENT

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) is seeking public comment on a draft hazardous waste permit for the Waste Isolation Pilot Plant, (WIPP). WIPP is located north of Jal Highway (State Highway 128) in Eddy County, approximately 26 miles east of Carlsbad, New Mexico. NMED issued a Public Notice on **August 6, 2018**, to announce the beginning of a 45-day comment period that will end at 5 p.m. on **September 20, 2018**. During this period, the public may comment on the draft Permit and/or request a public hearing.
