The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) issued a public hearing notice on September 22, 2018 to announce a public hearing and public comment period regarding a draft hazardous waste facility permit for the Waste Isolation Pilot Plant (WIPP). WIPP is located north of Jal Highway (State Highway 128) in Eddy County, approximately 26 miles east of Carlsbad, New Mexico. The public hearing is scheduled in Carlsbad beginning October 23, 2018 through October 25, 2018.
