FOR EXTENSION OF THE DEADLINE
FOR FILING PROPOSED FINDINGS OF FACT,
CONCLUSIONS OF LAW AND CLOSING
ARGUMENT

COMES NOW Southwest Research and Information Center (SRIC), pursuant to 20 NMAC 1.4.204.B, and requests an Extension of the Deadline for Filing Proposed Findings of Fact and Conclusions of law until November 26, 2018 at 5:00 p.m. MST.

As grounds therefor, SRIC states that the October 24, 2018 transcript of the hearing of this matter has been delayed, which further reduces the limited amount of time available to prepare the post-hearing filings.

Pursuant to 20 NMAC 1.4.502, thirty (30) days are normally provided to prepare Proposed Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law and Closing Argument "after filing of the transcript." The existing deadline of November 21, 2018 does not provide the normal 30-day time period after filing of any of the transcripts, and with the current delay, considerably less time than 30 days will be provided from whenever the October 24, 2018 transcript is filed.

Pursuant to 20 NMAC 1.4.204.B., SRIC has consulted with all other parties. Nuclear Watch New Mexico and Steve Zappe support this motion. The Permittees, NMED, and Concerned Citizens for Nuclear Safety do not oppose the motion.

WHEREFORE, SRIC requests that the Hearing Officer grant this Unopposed Motion and such other relief as he deems proper.
