

Dear Ms. Harris:

I invite you to participate in a meeting of stakeholders concerning the Waste Isolation Pilot Plant; the meeting is being hosted by the New Mexico Environment Department. As you may be aware, the Department of Energy's Carlsbad Area Office has requested the opportunity to revise its Part B permit application for WIPP. DOE wishes to revise the application to "reflect the current programmatic direction regarding the WIPP."
