- The results and end of SPM-2.


The meeting should begin at 8:00 a.m. and last until at least 5:00 p.m. to provide plenty of time for technical exchange.

- The natural resources study being completed by the New Mexico Bureau of Mines and Mineral Resources.


Others may wish to attend as well.
