

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**SUMMARY OF ACTION ITEMS  
STAKEHOLDERS MEETING  
APRIL 6-7, 1995**

<b>Comment by</b>	<b>Comment</b>	<b>Commitment</b>
Garland Harris, CARD	Asked Mr. Dials to explain the drilling rate change that occurred in the proposed standard when it was at OMB. Claimed to have a redline version of the proposed standard that the DOE prepared for the EPA. Accused the DOE of changing the criteria.	Committed to have a summary of the OMB process available to the stakeholders during the meeting.  <i>Commitment was fulfilled later that morning.</i>
Bob Neill, EEG	Asked what the plans were for the position papers.	Les Shephard stated that the position papers will be on the CD-ROM. George Dials added that stakeholder comments on the position papers would be addressed.
Lindsay Lovejoy Attorney General's Office	Asked when the side calculations will be done.	Les Shephard responded that they would be done by September.
Several Stakeholders	There was a discussion of when information would be available and when there would be time to discuss the Performance Assessment.	George Dials reminded stakeholders that the information would be on the CD-ROM which will be available later this month. He also stated that there would be time in the afternoon to discuss the PA. Bob Bills added that the CAO would be publishing a record of all position paper questions and the responses.

Lindsay Lovejoy Attorney General's Office	Asked how the SPM choices will be announced.	George Dials said that the CAO will announce them and subsequently revise the project technical baseline (PTB) based on the activities. The DOE will not seek stakeholder concurrence on these choices. <i>Letter sent to Stakeholders on June 5, 1995, notifying them of, SPM-2 Decision.</i>
Lewis Mikelson Facilitator	When will stakeholders be asked to comment on the PTB.	George Dials pointed out that this is an ongoing process that started with the 1992 PA and has included the CSR, the position papers, the DCCA, and will include the reports for the selected activities and the final PA.
Lewis Mikelson Facilitator	When will the next snapshot be available.	Jim Mewhinney stated that the DCCA is the next snapshot for stakeholders, and in July the DCCA would be augmented with the disturbed calculations.
Lokesh Chaturvedi, EEG	Asked about the status for comment responses.	<i>SPM position papers were mailed in mid-May.</i>  Jim Mewhinney stated that the CAO was expecting to issue single volumes or responses for the CSR and the 1992 PA this month. <i>Projected date for distribution of 1992 PA is 6/8/95; CSR expected to go out 6/16/95.</i>
Garland Harris, CARD	Independent scientific people or citizens should be included on Engineered Alternatives panel.	Jim Mewhinney committed to respond to any written request within two weeks of receipt.
George Dials, DOE/CAO		Committed to continue the stakeholder process.
