- 1) DOE/CAO to provide EEG with copy of volume 1 of ORNL Treatment Feasibility Study dated September 15, 1995. (DOE Lead - Mike Brown).
- 2) DOE/CAO to provide EEG with copy of Hanford report on the use of existing facilities for making RH TRU ready for disposal. (DOE Lead - Mike Brown).
- 3) DOE/CAO to provide EEG with copy of Savannah River Study on making waste ready for disposal as soon as the DOE/CAO has a copy of the report. (DOE Lead - Mike Brown).
- 4) DOE/CAO to provide EEG with a copy of the Engineered Alternatives Cost/Benefit Study (anticipated October, 1995). (DOE Lead - Jim Mewhinney).
