

The *Implementation Plan* for the Disposal Phase Supplemental Environmental Impact Statement is expected to be approved by DOE Headquarters and issued soon. The four-chapter *Implementation Plan* describes alternatives, analyses to be undertaken, and plans for preparing the SEIS. A key part of the document is a summary of comments made during the scoping process last September and October.
