Dear Mr. Kieling:

This letter provides amended information to the October 18, 1999, notification of audits letter from our office. The WIPP Permittees audit of the Rocky Flats Environmental Technology site (RFETS) is being moved from December 6-10, 1999 to December 13-17, 1999 to allow RFETS to compile the required evidence of implementation of their program for the audit. The permittees audit of the Hanford Site remains unchanged and will be conducted the week of January 10-14, 2000.

I certify under penalty of law that this document and all attachments were prepared under my direction or supervision in accordance with a system designed to assure that qualified personnel properly gather and evaluate the information submitted.
