**INFORMATION REPOSITORIES FOR THE WASTE ISOLATION PILOT PLANT

The purpose of this notice is to inform you that the U.S. Department of Energy (DOE) has established three repositories for information associated with the corrective action activities at the Waste Isolation Pilot Plant (WIPP). This notice is provided to all individuals on the WIPP Facility mailing list maintained by the Secretary of the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED). These information repositories were established to provide the public an opportunity to review and comment on the corrective action activities specified in Module VII of the Hazardous Waste Permit for WIPP. As required by Module VII of the WIPP Hazardous Waste Permit, the DOE will place copies of all completed documents related to corrective action activities in the information repositories. These documents will include correspondence, progress reports, work plans, reports, and other documents deemed appropriate by the NMED Secretary. Each document placed in the repository will include the date of submittal to the repository. The documents will be placed in the repositories on or before the date the submittal is due to the NMED Secretary.

At least five days prior to the due date of each submittal required by Module VII, the DOE will provide additional notices to all individuals on the facility mailing list. These notices will define the date that the submittal will be made available for public review at the information repositories.

Written comments concerning each scheduled submittal should be forwarded to the NMED representative identified in the notice, within 15 calendar days of the date each submittal is due to the NMED Secretary.

Individuals wishing to be included on the facility mailing list must submit a written request either to the NMED Secretary or to the DOE at the address in the letter head above.
