Dear Mr. Roderick:

In accordance with the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Management Regulations (HWMR-6), Part VI, Section 40 CFR 265.112(a), the owner or operator of a hazardous waste management facility must have a written closure plan by May 19, 1981 and, until final closure is certified in accordance with Part VI, Section 40 CFR 265.115, a copy of the most current plan must be furnished to the Secretary of the New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) upon request, including request by mail. On behalf of the Secretary of NMED, I am requesting a copy of your most recent closure plans for all hazardous waste management units at your facility which are subject to the interim status requirements of Part VI, Section 40 CFR 265.


The plans must address all requirements of Part VI, Section 265.111 through 265.116. The plans should specify the year that closure activities will be initiated for each unit. Please submit the closure plans within 30 days of receipt of this letter. The plans should be submitted to:

Additionally, any unit that is to be closed as a landfill or that must be closed as a landfill must have a post-closure plan. Please submit your post-closure plans for any landfill units at the facility within the same 30 day period. These plans must meet the requirements of Part VI, Section 265.117 through 265.120.
