The "Ground Water Remediation and Monitoring Annual Report" April 2004, Executive Summary, p. iii, paragraph 1, states, "To continue the investigation, Precision Engineering drilled twelve borings along the north side of Hammond Ditch in November." The only other information provided for this investigation is eleven of the twelve boring logs. NMED is interested in the preliminary information of what occurred during the investigation and what was found.

NMED is requesting the following within the next two weeks as this may influence the discharge plan.

- Provide a map identifying the locations of the 12 soil borings along the north side of Hammond Ditch. Identify the locations that contain 2 " hand slotted PVC.
- Provide the depths at which samples were collected.
- Provide the boring log SB10-1103.
- Provide any laboratory results and chain of custodies for the soil borings samples if any were collected.
- Provide a brief description of sampling procedures.
- Provide any conclusions drawn from this investigation.

On a side note, NMED and OCD are planning to visit the first week of August to discuss the discharge plan and a direction to take in order to move forward with groundwater remediation and investigation. We will be in touch with more details.
