NMED received the letter dated November 5, 2004 River Samples. It appears from the laboratory analysis that the "river downstream" sample was only analyzed for DRO, GRO, and 8021B. According to the "Monitoring and Contingency Plan," this sample should have also been analyzed for the WQCC metals, SVOCs, and general chemistry.

Giant shall clarify why the river downstream sample was not analyzed for WQCC metals, SVOCs, and general chemistry.

All future river water samples shall be analyzed by the analytical methods stated in the Monitoring and Contingency Plan.
