Western Refining Southwest, Inc. ("Western") is scheduled to conduct the Annual Sampling Event at the Bloomfield Terminal starting the week of August 17th, 2015. Locations from which samples will be collected during this sampling event include the Refinery Complex, North Boundary Barrier, San Juan River Bluff, and from the San Juan River. All annual groundwater monitoring activities will be performed pursuant to the guidelines outlined in the approved Facility-Wide Groundwater Monitoring Plan dated June 2014.

Prior to collecting groundwater samples, depth-to-groundwater and separate phase hydrocarbon (SPH) thickness measurements will be collected. Pumps equipped in each active recovery well will be turned off and groundwater levels will be allowed time to stabilize prior to collecting the depth-to-groundwater and SPH thickness measurements.
