Dear Mr. Kieling,

This letter is in response to NMED's letter concerning Corporate Transaction dated June 11, 2018 and received by the Bloomfield Terminal on August 16, 2018. San Juan Refining Company, as owner, and Western Refining Southwest, Inc., as operator, remain the legal entity names for the Bloomfield Terminal until further notice. Western Refining Southwest, Inc. was the result of a mere name change from Giant Industries Arizona, Inc.

Tesoro Corporation. On June 1, 2017, a wholly-owned subsidiary of Tesoro Corporation merged with and into Western Refining, Inc., the indirect parent company of the San Juan Refining Company and Western Refining Southwest, Inc. Furthermore, Western Refining, Inc., survived the merger as a wholly owned subsidiary of Tesoro Corporation.

Andeavor. On August 1, 2017, the Terminal's indirect parent company, Tesoro Corporation, changed its name to Andeavor. This was a name change. The San Juan Refining Company and Western Refining Southwest, Inc. did not change their names at that time. Following this change, the informal facility name has become Andeavor Bloomfield Terminal and contact email addresses have changed to include the Andeavor name.

Marathon Petroleum Corporation. This letter provides your office with notice of an upcoming transaction. In particular, Andeavor has entered into an agreement with Marathon Petroleum Corporation ("MPC") that, upon closing, will result in a series of mergers involving Andeavor and certain indirect subsidiaries of MPC. As a result, Andeavor will become an indirect subsidiary of MPC and convert to an LLC. All of Andeavor's current subsidiaries, including San Juan Refining Company and Western Refining Southwest, Inc., will remain in place as subsidiaries of Andeavor and indirect subsidiaries of MPC. These merger-related transactions will involve only Andeavor, and no changes to San Juan Refining Company and Western Refining Southwest, Inc., or its facility operations are anticipated. The transaction is expected to close in the second half of 2018. For planning purposes, we are working toward an October 1, 2018 target date.

In summary, the Bloomfield Terminal continues to be owned by San Juan Refining Company and operated by Western Refining Southwest, Inc, which are now indirect subsidiaries of Andeavor.
