Western Refining Southwest, Inc. - Bloomfield Terminal (Western) will delay the Semi-Annual Groundwater Monitoring Event at the Bloomfield Facility. Notification was sent on March 10, 2020 that Semi-Annual monitoring would start the week of April 6, 2020

The delay is the result of social distancing required for the COVID-19 outbreak. This Western Refining facility is critical to distribution of fuel in the four corners region and supply of crude oil to the Gallup refinery. The sampling will be rescheduled with another 2 week notice as soon as normal operations resume.
