
Western Refining Southwest, Inc. - Bloomfield Terminal (Western) initially scheduled the Semi-Annual Groundwater Monitoring Event at the Bloomfield Facility the week of April 6, 2020. Notification was provided to NMED and OCD on March 10, 2020. On April 1, 2020 Marathon Petroleum Company LP requested regulatory relief necessary to respond to the COVID-19.

Western has received NMED's Approval with Modifications response to Marathon's request. Western has made arrangements to measure water/product levels in all wells at the Bloomfield Terminal beginning May 25, 2020. We anticipate that gauging will be completed by May 27, 2020, weather permitting. Sampling activities will not be conducted.
