On February 1, 1991, the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) received your request for a Class I modification of your Resource Conservation and Recovery Act (RCRA) permit. The requested modification is for the addition of new waste codes to the permit without changes in the management practices. The waste codes to be added are F037 and F038.

This modification applies to the permit issued by the United States Environmental Protection Agency (USEPA) under the authority of the 1984 Hazardous and Solid Waste Amendments to the Resource Conservation and Recovery Act to Giant Refining Company, Gallup, New Mexico, (hereafter called the Permittee) to operate a hazardous waste disposal facility at the location stated above.

The Permittee must comply with all the terms and conditions of this permit. Modification of the HSWA section were carried out according to the procedures and authorizations of Title 40 Code of Federal Regulations 40 CFR 270.42.

This modified permit shall be effective September 18, 1991, and shall remain in effect until December 15, 1998, unless modified, revoked and reissued, or terminated in accordance with 40 CFR 270.41, 270.42, and 270.43. The administrative authority may issue any permit for duration that is less than the maximum term of ten years, and the term shall not be extended by modification in accordance with CFR 270.50 (b).

PERMIT MODIFICATION

On February 1 1991, Giant Refining Company submitted a Class I permit modification in order to continue managing newly listed wastes under the Petroleum Refinery Primary and Secondary Separation Sludge Rule. The wastes to be added were F037 and F038.

There are no pending enforcement actions against this facility. The last inspection by the NMED on March 6, 1991, revealed no major or minor code violations.

ACTION

The Class I permit modification is approved for the following reason:

1. The waste codes, F037 and F038, were added to an already regulated waste stream.
