Dear Mr. Stokes:

During a January 8, 1992 meeting between Hazardous and Radioactive Materials Bureau (HRMB) staff and a member of your staff, Mr. Lynn Shelton, Mr. Shelton was questioned as to when Giant Refining Company (GRC) would be submitting the required documentation of the Sonsela aquifer flow rate and direction, as required under the facility permit (Attachment G: Groundwater Monitoring Plan, 2., E.). Mr. Shelton responded that he was not aware of the requirement and would look into it immediately. Internal review by HRMB of submittals from GRC for 1990 reveal that this requirement was not met for 1990 either.


Failure to submit the documentation as required per the facility permit is a violation of the permit and may result in the issuance of a **Notice of Violation** to GRC. In order to fulfill the requirements of the facility permit GRC must submit the

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documentation as required in the permit (Attachment G: Groundwater Monitoring Plan, 2.,E.) for both 1990 and 1991 by March 1, 1992.
