Describe Cause of Problem and Remedial Action Taken: **Between 1705 and 1725 at tank 232 approximately 2,184 gallons of transmix (gasoline/diesel) ran over. At 1730 the release was discovered and remedial actions were taken. The release was contained within secondary containment and did not reach any waterways**

Describe Area Affected and Cleanup Action Taken **Upon discovery personnel took action to stop the release. Also, a vacuum truck was dispatched and approximately 80% (1747gallons) was recovered. Cause(s) of the run over are under investigation at this time.**
