The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) received Giant Refining Company's Ciniza Refinery (Permittee) *Dye Trace Study 2006*, dated June 19, 2006. NMED has accepted the document for technical review. NMED will provide the Permittee with a full technical review after the appropriate fees have been received. The fee invoice will be sent to you under separate cover. Upon receipt of the payment, NMED will initiate the technical review of the report in accordance with 20.4.2.200.A(7) NMAC.

Payment is due within sixty (60) calendar days from the date that you receive the invoice. If you disagree with the fee assessed, you may file an Administrative Appeal under the provisions of 20.4.2.302.1 NMAC.

If payment is by check, then you must provide the invoice number on the check. If payment is transmitted electronically, then you must submit a letter to Mr. James Valdez, Hazardous Waste Bureau, indicating the invoice number, payment amount, and the assessed activity prior to transferring funds. If the NMED does not receive notification, it will not begin the technical review of the document.
