We have the green light from Red Rocks Landfill in Thoreau to send them the waste soil from the cleanup of the banks of the aeration lagoons and Pond 2. We really don't have any alternative other than to dispose at Red Rocks Landfill. The soil in our landfarm from the current 6" lift is not yet at threshold that would enable us to apply it there. Please let me know if Red Rocks is acceptable as end point for this material.
