Remarks: Jim Lieb left a message reporting a spill at the tuck loading racks.

The spill occurred at ~ 12:30 at the truck loading rack while cleaning out the back of a tanker truck. The back of the truck was being flushed out, when liquid was released from the back of the truck. Most of the liquid was contained in the truck loading area containment pad. Some liquid was released over the pad onto the ground. Giant is estimating ~300 gallons of gasoline product spilled onto ground. Jim was not sure how much liquid was spilled onto the pad.

No waterways were reached or environmentally sensitive areas. Giant is currently cleaning up the spill and excavating soil. Giant will submit a C-141 form and email a description of the spill. Giant also contacted Carl Chavez of OCD.

12/6/07 – Spoke with Martin Nee ((505) 320-9675) who works for Giant Transportation – he is working with Carl Chavez OCD on clean up of the spill. He is collecting confirmation the samples from the spill, they are going to analyze for 8260, RCRA 8 metals, MTBE, TPH (GRO and DRO). He is going to send the analytical results here.
