Dear Kristen and John:

In the second paragraph of Comment 2 of the attached Approval With Modification of the Revised Railroad Rack Lagoon Overflow Ditch and Fan Out Area Report., the HWB lets Western demonstrate compliance that residual contamination with the industrial standard of 890 mg/kg for #3 and #6 fuel oil. In the attached NOD report for the Railroad Rack Pipeline; Comment 3 requires Permittee to excavate soil to residential/industrial levels of DRO (200 mg/kg) .

Since the fuel oil that passed through the pipeline addressed in the NOD was the same as what was cleaned up from the lagoon and fanout area, Western would like to request the use of the industrial fuel oil standard (890 mg/kg) also for the pipeline cleanup.
