The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) received Western Refining Southwest Inc., Gallup Refinery's (the Permittee) *Notification of Class 3 Permit Modification Request for Corrective Action Complete*, dated February 2017 and received February 3, 2017. The NMED has determined that the submittal is administratively complete. The submittal includes changes to the text in the 2013 RCRA Permit and a modification request for corrective action complete determination for three sites. The New Mexico Hazardous Waste Permit and Corrective Action Fee Regulations, 20.4.2.201.B(2)(a) NMAC, require the assessment of fees after a Permit application is deemed administratively complete. The fee invoice is attached to this letter. Upon receipt of the payment, the NMED will initiate a technical review of the submittal in accordance with 20.4.2.201.B(3) NMAC.



If you disagree with the fee assessed, you may notify the NMED in writing, at the address above, of the intent to appeal the invoice under the provisions of 20.4.2.302.A NMAC.
