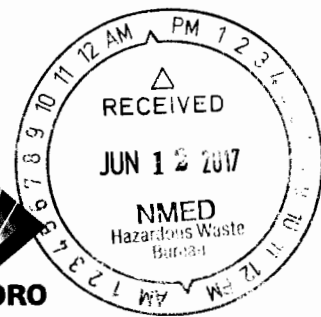

**Re: Follow-Up Notification Regarding Corporate Transaction  
Western Refining Southwest, Inc.  
Gallup Refinery RCRA Post-Closure Permit, No. NM000333211, and  
NMED v. San Juan Refining Company Order, No. HWB 07-34**

Dear Mr. Kieling:

I am writing to follow up on our previous correspondence in connection with (1) Western Refining Southwest, Inc.'s RCRA Post-Closure Permit, (Oct. 2013), No. NM000333211 ("Gallup Refinery Permit") and (2) the *NMED v. San Juan Refining Company Order*, No. HWB 07-34 (July 27, 2007) ("Bloomfield Refinery Order").

The Gallup Refinery Permit and Bloomfield Refinery Order were issued to subsidiaries of Western Refining, Inc. ("Western Refining"). The Gallup Refinery Permit was issued to Western Refining Southwest, Inc. The Bloomfield Refinery Order was issued to Giant Industries Arizona, Inc. (now Western Refining Southwest, Inc.) and San Juan Refining Company.

By letter dated January 30, 2017, I notified you that Tesoro Corporation ("Tesoro") was planning to acquire the stock of Western Refining via merger in a publically announced transaction. The letter was intended to provide notice of the transaction under § I.J.3 of the Gallup Refinery Permit and § III.E of the Bloomfield Refinery Order.


By letter dated February 6, 2017, you acknowledged receiving my letter and confirmed that Tesoro submitted notification of the corporate transaction in accordance with § I.J.3 of the Gallup Refinery Permit, § III.E of the Bloomfield Refinery Order and 40 C.F.R. § 270.40(b). You also requested that notification be sent of the completed transaction within ten business days after the transaction has been completed.

Tesoro hereby provides notification that the transaction was completed on June 1, 2017.

In addition, it is now anticipated that Western Refining Southwest, Inc., will change its name on July 31, 2017, to Andeavor SW Southwest Inc. Please confirm that this notice of the name change is sufficient under the Gallup Refinery Permit and the Bloomfield Refinery Order.
