
Dear Ms. O'Brien:

The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has received the Western Refining Southwest Inc., Gallup Refinery (Permittee) *Extension Request* (Extension Request), dated August 30, 2018. The Permittee requests a 60 day extension of time to submit the 2017 Facility-Wide Groundwater Monitoring Report. RCRA Permit Section IV.C.3 (Facility-Wide Groundwater Monitoring Reports) requires that the annual facility-wide groundwater monitoring report be submitted no later than September 1st of each year. The Permittee requests an extension of time due to the need to resolve issues regarding comments from NMED, respond to comments, and submit revisions for the previous two years of groundwater monitoring data. NMED hereby issues this Approval. The Permittee must submit 2017 Facility-Wide Groundwater Monitoring Report no later than **October 30, 2018**.
