The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has received the *Notification of Corporate Transaction* letter, dated August 16, 2018 and received August 20, 2018. Attached to the letter is an updated RCRA Part A permit application. Transfer of a permit requires prior agency approval as specified in 40 CFR 270.40(b) this action requires prior approval and therefore is considered to be a Class 1 permit modification with prior approval subject to the fees included in 20.4.2.207 NMAC. NMED has accepted the submittal for review in accordance with the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Permit and Corrective Action Fee Regulations, 20.4.2.201.B(2) NMAC. NMED will review the submittal after the appropriate fees have been received. Upon receipt of payment, NMED will initiate its review of the submittal in accordance with 20.4.2.201.B(3) NMAC.



If you disagree with the fees assessed, you may notify the NMED in writing, at the address above, of the intent to appeal the invoices under the provisions of 20.4.2.302.A NMAC.

If payment is by check, then you must provide the invoice number on the check. If payment is transmitted electronically, then you must submit a letter to Mr. Brian Holton, NMED Hazardous Waste Bureau, indicating the invoice number, payment amount, and the assessed activities prior to transferring funds.
