The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has received the Marathon Petroleum Company LP dba Western Refining Southwest Inc., Gallup Refinery (the Permittee) extension request letter (Request) for the *Investigation Report OW-14 Source Area Comment 3 SPH Analysis and Comment 24 Tank Inspection Reports*, dated May 23, 2019 and received May 28, 2019. NMED's April 2, 2019 Disapproval requires submittal of the response to Comment 3 by May 31, 2019. The Permittee references Comment 24 in the Request; however, it is not relevant to the required response. The Permittee requests to extend the due date for submittal of the response until June 28, 2019.


