
The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has received the Marathon Petroleum Company LP dba Western Refining Southwest Inc., Gallup Refinery (the Permittee) extension request letter (Request) for the *Work Plan 2015 Annual Groundwater Report Comments*, dated May 23, 2019 and received May 28, 2019. NMED's January 28, 2019 Disapproval requires submittal of the revised work plan by June 3, 2019. The Permittee requests to extend the due date for submittal of the work plan until June 28, 2019.

RCRA Permit Section I.J.12 states, "[t]he Permittee may seek an extension of time in which to perform a requirement of this Permit, for good cause, by sending a written request for extension of time and proposed revised schedule to the NMED." The Permittee requests an extension to "complete the necessary revisions." NMED hereby grants the requested extension.
