The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has received the *Area of Concern 15 – New API Separator and Area of Concern 16 – New API Separator Overflow Tanks Investigation Work Plan*, dated March 31, 2022, and received on March 30, 2022. The NMED has accepted the submittal for review in accordance with the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Permit and Corrective Action Fee Regulations, 20.4.2.201.B(2) NMAC. NMED will review the submittal after the appropriate fees have been received. The fee invoice is attached to this letter. 

If payment is by check, then you must provide the invoice number on the check. If payment is transmitted electronically, then you must submit a letter to Mr. Dave Cobrain, NMED Hazardous Waste Bureau, indicating the invoice number, payment amount, and the assessed activity prior to transferring funds.
