The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has reviewed the U.S. Army White Sands Missile Range (Permittee) *Hazardous Waste Storage Facility Permit NM2750211235 Renewal Application Resubmittal* (Permit Application), dated August 2020 with final revisions received on March 24, 2021. The revised Permit Application was prepared in response to NMED's October 2019 Administratively Incomplete determination and subsequent closure plan amendments and adequately addresses all of NMED's comments regarding the Permit Renewal Application. NMED hereby determines that the Permit Application is Administratively Complete.

The New Mexico Hazardous Waste Permit and Corrective Action Fee Regulations, 20.4.2.201.B(2)(a) NMAC, require the assessment of fees after an application is deemed administratively complete. The fee invoice is attached to this letter. Upon receipt of the payment, the NMED will initiate a technical review of the submittal in accordance with 20.4.2.201.B(3) NMAC.
