The New Mexico Environment Department (NMED) has received White Sands Missile Range (WSMR) document, *2020 Groundwater Frequent Monitoring Report, SWMU 198, LC-38 Diesel Fuel Oil Release*, dated January 2021 and received May 13, 2021. NMED has accepted the submittal for review in accordance with the New Mexico Hazardous Waste Permit and Corrective Action Fee Regulations, 20.4.2.201.B(2) NMAC.
